REACH Air Medical Services Now Providing Air Medical Transport Services from Napa County

Napa, CA – June 6, 2018 – REACH Air Medical Services has announced that it is now providing air medical transport services from the Napa County Airport located in Napa, California. The base will provide emergency air medical transport services 24-hours a day, seven days a week to the communities of Napa County and the surrounding regions.

“We are extremely proud of this expansion,” said Sean Russell, President of REACH Air Medical Services. “We look forward to strengthening our service to Napa County by providing a vital air medical resource to the community and local hospitals and EMS agencies with a dependable partner in patient care.”

“We are very pleased to have a REACH helicopter added to our EMS resources in Napa County,” said Bruce Lee, Regional Director of American Medical Response Napa. “This new resource will enhance the 911 system significantly, as well as strengthen the inter-hospital transfer system for critically ill patients.”

The year-round air medical base is staffed by a team of highly trained and experienced pilots and clinicians. And in addition to operating under an advanced scope of clinical practice, the Flight Nurses and Flight Paramedics at REACH's Napa location are also trained in the treatment and transport of high-risk obstetrics, neonatal and pediatric patients.

Every aircraft operated by REACH is medically configured and fully-equipped with the latest in avionics and safety features. In addition to this, the EC-135 helicopter that has been designated for the Napa region is also equipped to house an isolette which allows for the safe transport of pediatric and neonatal patients.

REACH, which acquired CALSTAR Air Medical Services in 2016, operates several additional air medical transport bases throughout the North and East Bay – including Contra Costa, Sonoma, Lake, and Mendocino Counties. The close proximity of each of these locations allows for additional air transport coverage for each of these counties – an added benefit to the community.

REACH is a participating provider in the AirMedCare Network (AMCN), the nation's largest air medical transport membership program. When transported by REACH, AMCN members incur no out of pocket expense for a medically necessary flight. Membership is just \$85 a year for an entire household or \$65 a year for seniors. In addition to covering flight costs for REACH, membership extends to AMCN's 320 base locations across 38 states.
